DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE – CARITAS CANADA Help us help our sisters and



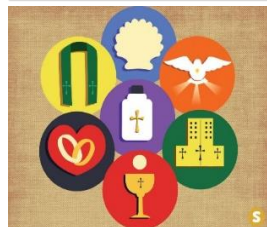

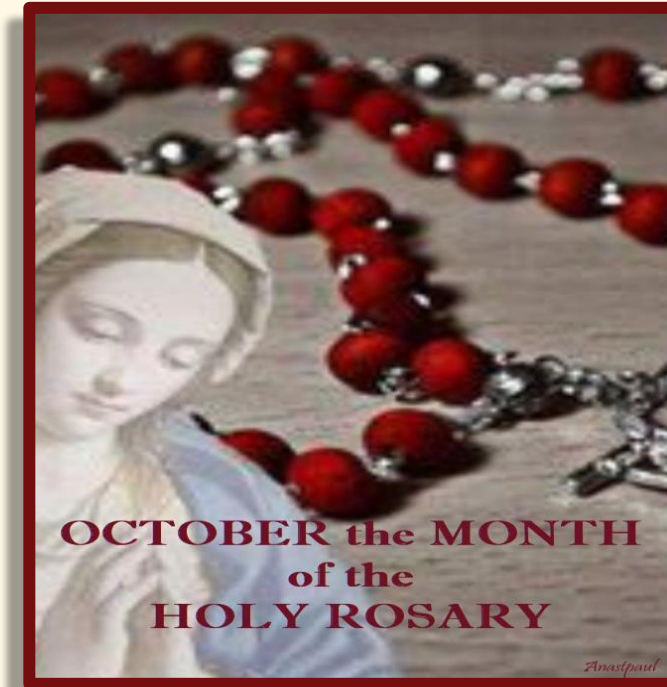
