FROM THE OFFICE OF BISHOP MIEHM: KEY MESSAGES - EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL PROTECTION ACT STAY-AT-HOME ORDER

The provincial government declared a 28-day State of Emergency and issued a Stay-at-Home Order yesterday. These measures are in addition to the Emergency Brake Shutdown that took effect on Holy Saturday.

The 15% capacity limit for places of worship remains in place, and therefore parish churches are open for Sunday and Daily Masses. The Missions may be opened or closed at the discretion of the pastor.

The *Stay-at-Home Order* does not apply to parishioners making the trip from home to the church. (Legislation reference - EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL PROTECTION ACT STAY-AT-HOME ORDER, SCHEDULE I, 1. (1). 24.) Adhering to the *COVID-19 Safety Plan* and the *WorshipSafe* guidelines is critically important as the province undertakes these measures to curtail the spread of the COVID-19 virus, especially the Variants of Concern (VOC).
