Grant them eternal rest, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them with your Saints forever more, because You are gracious.

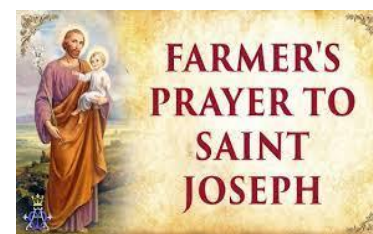
May the divine assistance remain always with us. And may the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

4. Scroll down to the survey which is in 2 formats: A) “Thought Exchange”: (which allows one to see the anonymous responses of others which may germinate some reflection)

9. There will be a discussion concerning the “Mission” questionnaire during all Masses on November 27-28 in place of the homily.
10. For those unable to attend the Masses on November 27-28, there will a gathering in the church building on Thursday, December 2nd @ 7:00pm.
