#### MESSAGES FROM Fr. RANDY:

##### DEAR FRIENDS,

One Word at a Time- **DO**  
**Living in the mercy of God means much more than thinking or talking about it. We live God's mercy when we do something that brings mercy to others. "Which of these three . . . was neighbor to the man?" He said, "the one who showed him mercy." Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise." (Luke 10:36-37)**

Dear Friends in Christ; We have been Marked with ashes. We began this past week with our annual Lenten pilgrimage, not proudly, but humbly, as the Church invites each of us again to heed our Lord's invitation to return to Him with our whole hearts. At Holy Mass this weekend, we hear of another return proclaimed in the Gospel, that of the return of our Lord from His own baptism in the Jordan to the desert in which he is tempted by the evil one. If we are sincere in our desire to return to the Lord this Lent, then the desert cannot be avoided for you and for me. The desert is not a place to be feared, but rather the place in which we can be known and loved by the Lord, a place where all is laid bare and anything that is not of God can be stripped away. Into the desert the Church goes this weekend, and invites each of us to follow, not alone, but with one another and, together, we return to Jesus, who from the desert then returns to Galilee to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord (Luke 4:19). This is the acceptable time to return to the Lord.

##### THE HOLY EUCHARIST: DID YOU KNOW?

Just looking with love and devotion upon the Blessed Sacrament during the Consecration or during Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at a Holy Hour will increase our glory in Heaven. This sweet and loving insight was shared by Our Lord with St. Gertrude, who transcribed it in her manuscript, "The Revelations of St. Gertrude." The tremendous power of God's Presence in the Holy Eucharist is beyond our comprehension: for just to look with love upon the Consecrated Host can add to our heavenly glory for all eternity.

**REFLECTION:** Why not consider expanding your love for Jesus this Lent by writing a love letter to Jesus. Tell him how you feel while you look upon him during the Eucharist or when you receive his Sacred Body during communion. (Write it out then burn it as an offering).

**PEACE WITHIN** May today there be peace within. May you trust God that you are exactly where you are meant to be. May you not forget the infinite possibilities that are born of faith. May you use those gifts that you have received and pass on the love that has been given to you. Let this presence settle into your bones, and allow your soul the freedom to sing, dance, praise, and love. It is there for each and every one of us. St. Therèse of Lisieux and St. Theresa of Avila
