



MESSAGES FROM Fr. RANDY:

Dear Friends, Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed! Alleluia! On this Sunday, the first day of the week, alongside the Apostles and St. Mary Magdalene, the Church finds herself again before the tomb whose stone has been rolled away and invites each of us to dare to proclaim and rejoice in the glory of the Resurrection of the Lord. At Holy Mass in these days of the Easter Octave, the Church sings these words of an ancient sequence, Victimae paschali laudes, in thanksgiving for the most awesome event of the Lord's Resurrection.

Christians, to the Paschal Victim, offer your thankful praises!

A Lamb the sheep redeems; Christ, who only is sinless, reconciles sinners to the Father. Death and life have contended in that combat stupendous: The Prince of life, who died, reigns immortal. Speak, Mary, declaring what you saw, wayfaring. "The tomb of Christ, who is living, the glory of Jesus' resurrection; bright angels attesting, the shroud and napkin resting. Yes, Christ my hope is arisen; to Galilee he goes before you." Christ indeed from death is risen, our new life obtaining. Have mercy, victor King, ever reigning! Amen. Alleluia. Fr. Randy

One Word at a Time **ENLIVED**


The mercy of God is a lifegiving power that can even restore the dead to new life. God's mercy enlivens us when we are crushed by the death-dealing forces of sin. God's mercy raises us up. But God, who is rich in



mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ. (Ephesians 2:4–5)

THE HOLY EUCHARIST: DID YOU KNOW?

Alleluia! "He is not here, He has risen." (Luke 24: 5) Why not travel with Mary Magdalene, St. Peter, and St. John to see the empty tomb? Imagine the glorious surprise of finding the tomb empty and the burial cloth which covered Jesus' face, neatly folded, and left aside. (John 20:1-9)



REFLECTION: The glorious resurrection of Jesus is the great triumph of the Cross. It is the great doctrine of Christianity. That same glorified, risen body of Our Lord is present to all of us Catholic Christians under the guise of the Holy Eucharist. 
