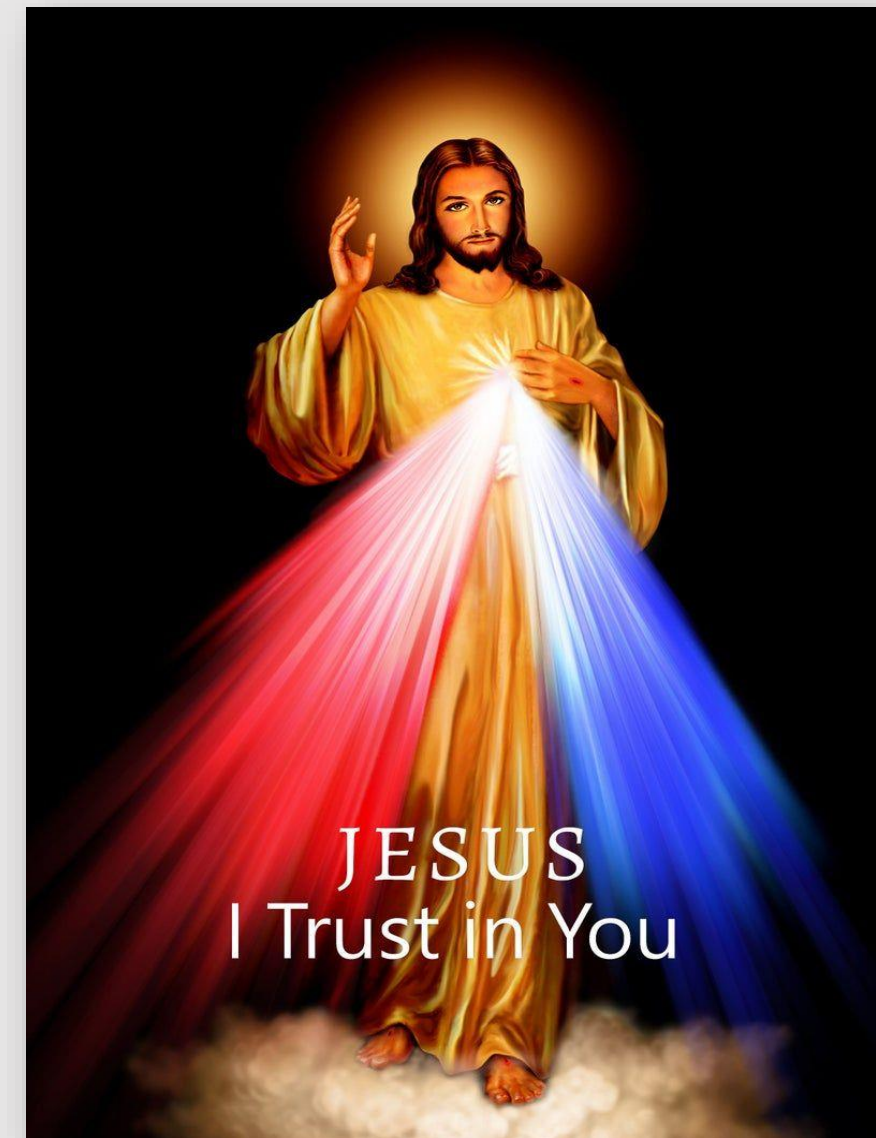



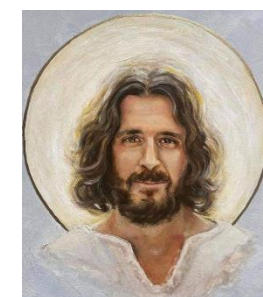

MESSAGES FROM Fr. RANDY: Dear Friends, it really was a great celebration for our parishes as we remembered the Passion, Death and Resurrection of our Lord! Many thanks to all who worked so hard on the many liturgical celebrations, thank-you. The danger is that, when we have a celebration, life goes back to normal the next day. In a culture that is fast-paced and production-driven and consumption-oriented, we as Christians are called to witness that something has changed, that we have changed the way we will live life in this passing world. We are to show that the Resurrection has "soaked in," and that we are different because Jesus has changed our destiny. As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, let us abound in merciful acts that we pray help change the world. The reality of war (pray for the Ukraine!), the violence and disrespect for all life and lack of justice and peace for all, the absence of love, can all be remedied by Christ though our acts of mercy and kindness. As our Jewish friends so aptly remind us in the proverb that one small act of kindness and mercy saves the world, let's start small but powerfully in anything that can help others, not just one day, not just fifty days, but always! EASTER CORNER

One Word at a Time LOVE
 The mercy of God is like the tender love a parent has toward his or her child. Even when that child moves in a wrong direction, the parent's love remains. So it is with us and the mercy of God. When

Israel was a child, I loved him, and out of Egypt I called my son. - e more I called them, the more they went from me. I led them with cords of human kindness, with bands of love. I was to them like those who lift infants to their cheeks. (Hosea 11:1-2,4)

THE HOLY EUCHARIST: DID YOU KNOW?

Take a moment to find the image of Jesus, The Divine Mercy, displayed in our Church. This image was painted at the request of Our Lord. It depicts a vision of Christ as He appeared to St. Faustina. The vision shows red and white streams of light emanating from His Heart. As Jesus hung on the cross, a soldier pierced His side and immediately blood and water poured forth. The image shows these red beams, which denote the Precious Blood and the white beams, which denote the waters of Baptism.

In another vision, St. Faustina saw these same beams of heavenly red and white light, but this time they were coming from the Holy Eucharist and enveloping the entire world.

This indicates that the flow of merciful graces from Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament pours forth from His Heart and envelops all.

REFLECTION: Jesus asked that beneath the image of The Divine Mercy the words, "Jesus, I trust in You." should be written. He promised that the more a soul trusted in His Mercy, the more He would give to the soul. He revealed to St. Faustina that the greatest attribute of God is MERCY.

When we receive the Holy Eucharist, how much to de trust that Christ is truly present to us as an intimate, personal, and loving friend? Jesus assures us in the Divine Mercy of the Holy Eucharist that He is Love and Mercy incarnate. Take time after the reception of Holy Communion to be with Him in grateful prayer.

"The fifty days from the Sunday of the Resurrection to Pentecost Sunday are celebrated in joy and exultation as one feast day, indeed as one 'great Sunday'." (St. Athanasius)
