

THE HOLY EUCHARIST: DID YOU KNOW?



The gift of the Holy Eucharist is precious beyond measure. Here is an insight into one aspect of the treasure of the Blessed Sacrament from St. Maximillian Kolbe, the martyr of

Auschwitz. St. Maximillian volunteered to die in the place of a married prisoner in a starvation bunker. What gives anyone such selfless courage? "You come to me and unite Yourself intimately to me under the form of nourishment. Your Blood now runs in mine. Your Soul, Incarnate God, compenetrates mine, giving courage and support". (St. Maximillian Kolbe)

Reflection: We can only begin to understand in some small manner, the Divine power which is present to us in the Blessed Sacrament. St. Maximillian was given the grace of martyrdom and attributed this strength directly to the Holy Eucharist, Why not return to Mass each Sunday to receive the true physical presence of the Jesus in the Holy Eucharist? We are all in great need of this spiritual nourishment, as we each bear our individual crosses in life.
