<u>MESSAGES FROM Fr. RANDY:</u> Dear Friends in Christ,

The Holy Eucharist: DID YOU KNOW?

The Blessed Mother conceived the Infant Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit. It is also by the power of the Holy Spirit that our priests are able to consecrate the bread and wine at Mass into the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus. Therefore, through the Holy Spirit, the priests give us the Holy Eucharist.

The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity. This "Spiritus Sanctus" is the Love between the Heavenly Father and His Beloved Son, Jesus. The Father is the Creator. The Son is the Redeemer. The Holy Spirit is the Sanctifier. This Third Divine Person is the one who enables the sanctification of our souls. He does this in the most perfect way by enabling the priest to give us Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Reflection: Spend some time on Pentecost Sunday thanking the Holy Spirit for His great gifts of grace, which make us holy. Especially thank Him for making the Holy Eucharist possible from the very first Mass on Holy Thursday to the current Mass we are attending today.
