

MESSAGES FROM Fr. RANDY: Dear Friends in Christ.

We gather this weekend to celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body, and Blood of Christ. This solemnity reminds us of the greatest gift that Christ gave to us. His very life, His own body and blood. This is a gift given freely to each of us to enable us to grow in our faith and have the strength to embrace and live the teaching of the Gospel. When we reflect on the sacrifices that Christ underwent every time, we receive the Holy Eucharist. The sadness of these times is how many Catholic no longer receive this greatest of all the gifts. It is that lack of participation in the Body of Christ that weakens His message to the world, a message that needs to be heard and lived now more than ever before. The very word "Eucharist" means thanksgiving in spite of the times in which we are living, we have much for which to be grateful. Even when we choose to turn our backs to the Lord. He is still there waiting for us...this alone is a gift! Let us fall on our knees in gratitude this weekend. Let us receive Eucharist more earnestly and reverently. Let us partake of this life-giving gift with a newness of heart. Jesus tells us unless we eat of His body and drink of His blood, we have no live in us. Let us find our way back to that life and encourage others to do the same.

The Holy Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. When the priest says the words "This is my Body ...This is my Blood," Catholics believe that the Host truly becomes Jesus Christ. God Himself descends from Heaven and makes Himself present to us. From any scientific analysis, the Eucharist still has all the appearances of bread, but its substance, meaning what it truly is, has now become the Second Person of the Trinity. The truth of the Real Presence of Christ has also been demonstrated throughout history by various Eucharistic Miracles. If you have time this week, I encourage you to learn about the Eucharistic Miracle of Lanciano, Italy, where God permitted the Eucharistic Body and Blood to remain physical flesh

and blood, rather than keeping the appearances of bread and wine. However, this miracle points to what happens at every Mass.

Why do Catholics believe that the Consecration changes the substance of bread and wine to the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus? Because Jesus gave us the Eucharist on Holy Thursday.

The Holy Eucharist: DID YOU KNOW?

"This is my Body that is given for you." (Corinthians 11:24) Celebrate the gift of the Holy Eucharist today with joy! Never forget that we, as Catholics, truly possess the living, glorified Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus in this Sacrament. St. Thomas Aquinas teaches that the Holy Eucharist is the "Sacrament of Sacraments" because it contains the whole Christ. The Blessed Sacrament augments our union with Jesus, forgives our venial sins and helps to preserve us from grave (mortal) sins. (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1416)

Reception of the Holy Eucharist helps us to grow in the spiritual life. In "Evangeli Gaudium" Pope Francis tells us that the Eucharist "is not a prize for the perfect, but powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak." Jesus knows that we need Him in our journey through life. It is because of His Love and Mercy that Our Lord instituted the Holy Eucharist.

Reflection: Especially recall today on this Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ that all saints have two outstanding characteristics. The first is a deep love of the Holy Eucharist. The second is a loving devotion to Our Lady.

Why not resolve today on this Feast to cultivate the heart of a saint by growing more profoundly in your love for Jesus in the Holy Eucharist?

While most men are somewhat shy about accepting our thanks and praise on a day like this, let that never keep us from thanking them and letting them know how special and important they are in our lives. No one is perfect, but this is a day to remember all that is good and thank God for them.

Father, it is your commandment that we should love our fathers; hear the prayers we offer You for them.
