The Holy Eucharist: DID YOU KNOW?

The source of our Life, Faith, Charity, and Virtue are all contained in the Holy Eucharist. Why? Simply because CHRIST is the source of all that is good, true, pure, and beautiful. St. Peter Julian Eymard stated, "Let us never forget that an age prospers or dwindles in proportion to its devotion to the Eucharist. This is the measure of its spiritual life."

Reflection: The evils, turmoil, injustices, violence, and ugliness which permeate our world can trace their roots back to a lack of love, reverence, prayer and respect for God. As our society embraces a more pagan lifestyle, the only sure source of recourse can be found in a return to the worship of God. God does not need our worship, but we humans certainly need to worship Him. And knowing this, Jesus is there waiting for us in the tabernacle of every Catholic Church and in every Communion Host.
