The Holy Eucharist: DID YOU KNOW?

This week's theme: Miracles of Conversion

“It is the destiny of every consecrated Host to melt with love on a human heart.” This tender quote was made by St. Jean Vianney, the Cure of Ars. He is the patron saint of parish priests, who spent hours of prayer in front of Jesus in the tabernacle. By doing so, he was able to convert tens of thousands of people after the French Revolution had tried to destroy their Faith. He was so successful that the French railroad system had to install tracks to take the flood of pilgrims directly to him in Ars. **Reflection:** What is the condition of our heart as we receive the Blessed Sacrament?
