I pray that you will receive many blessing during this Holy Week and know you are not walking alone, rather walking with many. **God Bless, Fr. Randy**

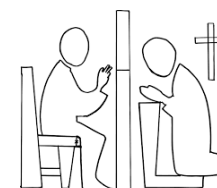

**This week is Palm Sunday**, the beginning of Holy Week. Let us do our best to keep these days sacred and meaningful.

**Monday April 3<sup>rd</sup> Chrism Mass 7: p.m.** @ St. Peter's Cathedral. Join Bishop Miehm, priests, religious and faithful of the diocese to celebrate the Blessing of the Sacramental Holy Oils and renewal of Priestly vows.

**Holy Thursday** – Lord Supper: the great gift of the Holy Eucharist was given by Jesus. **7p.m. mass**  
**Good Friday** Great Sacrifice of our Salvation. **3p.m. Service** (the only day that priest don't celebrate mass)  
**Holy Saturday East Vigil:** We are at the tomb waiting for the first rays of the resurrection.

**EASTER CONFESSIONS:** Fr. Randy has set aside extra time Thursday following the evening mass until 9p.m.

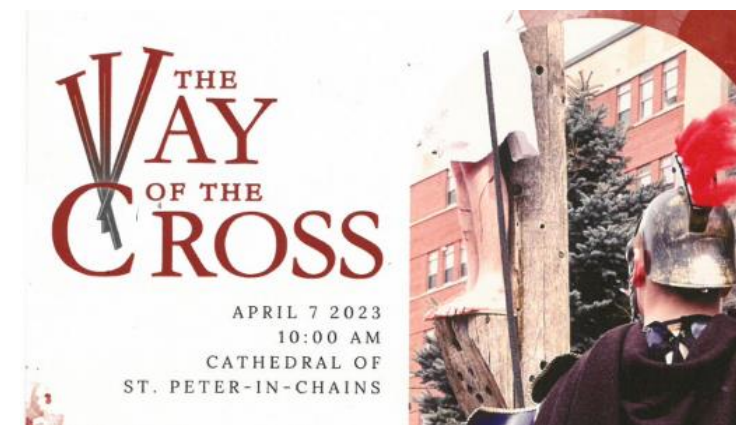

As we enter Holy Week, we recall that it was during the Lord's Last Supper that Jesus gave us both the Holy Eucharist and the Priesthood. We cannot have one without the other. If we have no priests, we won't have the Holy Eucharist.

**Reflection:** Father James Brent, O.P. who is a priest obviously devoted to the Eucharist wrote, “Though our weeks might be busy and our schedules might be full, the real reason to live is on Sunday.
