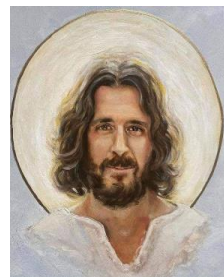

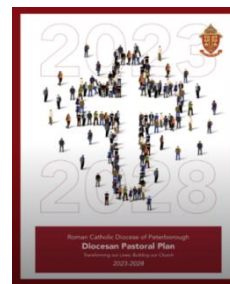

THE HOLY EUCHARIST: DID YOU KNOW!

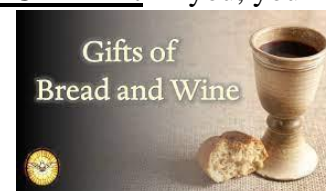
