

Our history: December 1865, Fr. Lynch was succeeded in by our 5th Pastor Fr. Daniel O'Connell, whose pastorate was one year short of a quarter century. In addition to Douro, Fr. O'Connell served missions in Burleigh, Stoney Lake, and Chandos which were flourish lumber operations. With the increase of parishioners Father build transepts, and a vestry to the original church,



thus making it cruciform in shape. Although the church was Gothic ins style, ceiling was flat. He also building present day church in Young's Point, frame church at Chandos, barn, shade, and at stable. On February 8, 1889, he was transferred to Ennismore. He died in 1909.




