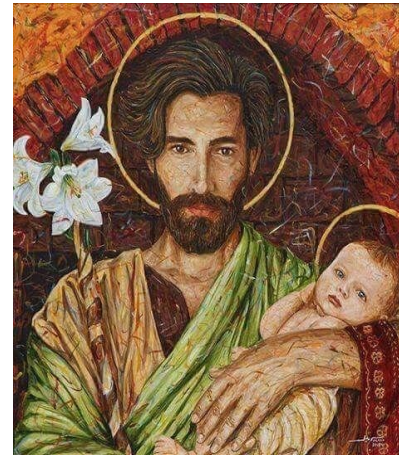

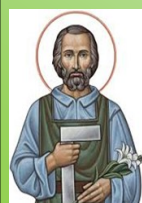

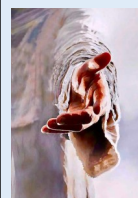
Candle at **Bless Mother Mary's** statue burns this week for: World Peace

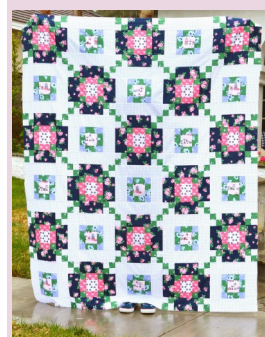
