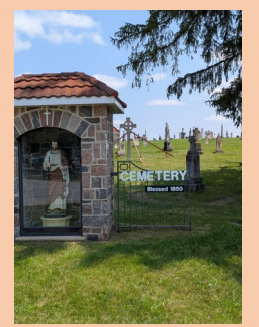
Note from Maryann Clancy



Dear Parishioners, I need to thank you so much for your prayers, masses and well wishes. Your faith in the Lord and prayers did so

much to carry me through the difficult treatments over the last months. My family and I are forever grateful for your overwhelming caring and support, including the tremendous fundraiser.
