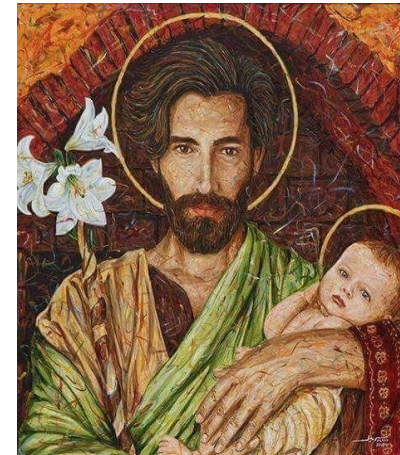

 May St. Joseph watch over you and help you in your new adventures. Fr. Randy and parishioners.


