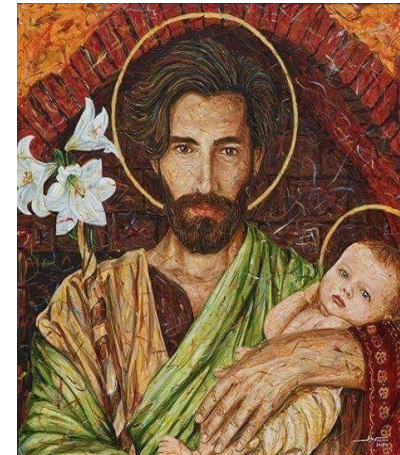

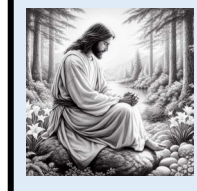

Candle at **Blessed Mother Mary** statue burns this week for: Lawrence Heffernan by Parishioner

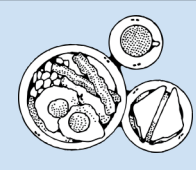


Candle at **St. Joseph** statue burns this week for: Kevin Meade by Parishioner
