**St. Anne's K of C annual Spaghetti Dinner Friday October 24 from 4:30-6:30 p.m.**



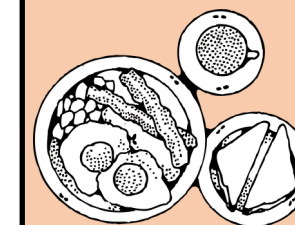
Cost is \$10 for adults, children 5-12 \$7 and children under 5 free.

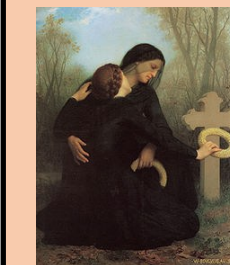
