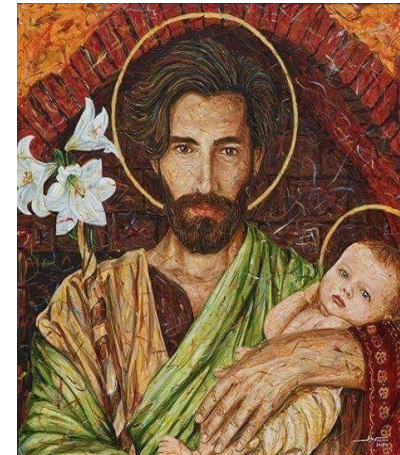


Candle Lite for this Week
