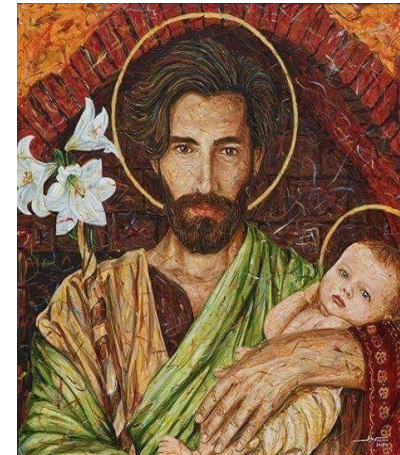


Candle Lite for this Week



Traveling Statue of St. Joseph If you would like to take the St. Statue home because of family sickness, our family concerns or just having him in your home for pray, just ask Father.





As we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany, I invite you to take part in a the traditional Epiphany House Blessing—a meaningful way to invite Christ into your home at the beginning of the new year.

The blessing is traditionally written above the main entrance as follows: **20 +C+M+B+26** The numbers represent the current year, and the letters recall the name of the Magi Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar. As well as the Latin phrase **Christus Mansionem Benedicat (May Christ bless this home)**. As a family or all those gathered at the door pray Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be. You may want to added a intercession of St. Joseph.

There will be blessed chalk at the back of the church for you to take home.
